Philosophy and Transparency

Legislation & regulations touch all aspects of our company. At Capital One, we believe that engaging in the legislative and regulatory rulemaking processes are important for our customers, business, and associates. Our advocacy often involves collaboration and thought leadership in the public and private sectors as well as advocating through lobbying and coalitions. Capital One's public policy agenda in the US is managed on a day-to-day basis by the Global Policy Affairs Group (GPAG), part of Capital One's Global Enterprise Affairs organization.

Our year end reports include additional information focused on:

- The company's Board of Directors role in overseeing Capital One's public policy engagement and political participation.
- Information on our dues to trade associations and social welfare organizations.
- Federal and state lobbying activities and related reporting.
- Contribution criteria and approval for Capital One's Corporate and Political Action Committee (PAC) Contributions.

The mid-year report outlines contributions made January 1 - June 30 of the calendar year. The Global Policy Affairs Group Annual Report is a compilation of all contributions for the year, as well as lobbying activities. The contributions are based on the calendar year in which they are approved, which may differ from when recipients report receiving the contribution. Contributions listed throughout the report are noted by the respective party, committee assignment, leadership role or designation as appropriate at the time of the contribution. Those can vary. A candidate may also hold a different office, however, the contribution is listed in relation to the office being sought when the contribution was made.

Capital One's contributions during the reporting period were all made in accordance with its Corporate and PAC Political Contributions Guidelines. Contributions for federal offices and some state and local offices are made through the Capital One Financial Corporation Associates Political Fund. Additionally, Capital One makes corporate contributions in states where permissible under law. These contributions are directed to statewide offices, state legislatures and local offices. All state contributions are included in this report and the public reporting by states and localities will vary by jurisdiction.
